THE FIRST THREE CHRISTMASSES

Dear Blessed and Beloved Followers of Our Lord Jesus:

This December 25th, I will have the honor of celebrating my 88th Christmas. As long ago as that may seem, it has been many more years since the first Christmas and the birth of our Lord Jesus. This holy event is well documented in the gospels of Matthew and Luke and is foretold throughout prophecies of the Old Testament. However, did you know that biblical record also gives account to the second and third Christmases?

Let us examine each of the first *three* Christmases.

The First Christmas—Christ Born of Mary

The first Christmas was celebrated nearly 2,000 years ago in the stables behind an inn in Bethlehem of Judah.

This glorious event, designed by God our Father, would provide salvation to lost mankind and change the world. The prophet Isaiah prophesied the event almost 600 years before its fulfillment (Isa. 7:14). Years after Isaiah, the prophet Micah declared that Bethlehem would be the place where this supernatural birth would take place (Mic. 5:2).

Let us read the account of the birth of Jesus from the book of Matthew chapter 1, beginning with verse 18:

“Now the birth of Jesus Christ was as follows: After His mother Mary was betrothed to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Spirit.

“Then Joseph her husband, being a just man, and not wanting to make a public example, was minded to put her away secretly. But while he thought about these things, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, ‘Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take to you Mary your wife, for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Spirit. And she will bring forth a Son, and you shall call His name Jesus, for He will save His people from their sins.’

“So all this was done that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the Lord through the prophet, saying: ‘Behold, the virgin shall be with child, and bear a Son, and they shall call His name Immanuel,’ which is translated, ‘God with us.’

“Then Joseph, being aroused from sleep, did as the angel of the Lord commanded him and took to him his wife, and did not

know her till she had brought forth her firstborn Son. And he called His name Jesus” (Matt. 1:18-25, NKJV).

Now, let us look at the account in the book of Luke chapter 2, beginning with verse 1:

“And it came to pass in those days that a decree went out from Caesar Augustus that all the world should be registered . . . So all went to be registered, everyone to his own city. Joseph also went up from Galilee, out of the city of Nazareth, into Judea, to the city of David, which is called Bethlehem, because he was of the house and lineage of David, to be registered with Mary, his betrothed wife, who was with child.

“So it was, that while they were there, the days were completed for her to be delivered. And she brought forth her firstborn Son, and wrapped Him in swaddling cloths, and laid Him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the inn.

“Now there were in the same country shepherds living out in the fields, keeping watch over their flock by night. And behold, an angel of the Lord stood before them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were greatly afraid.

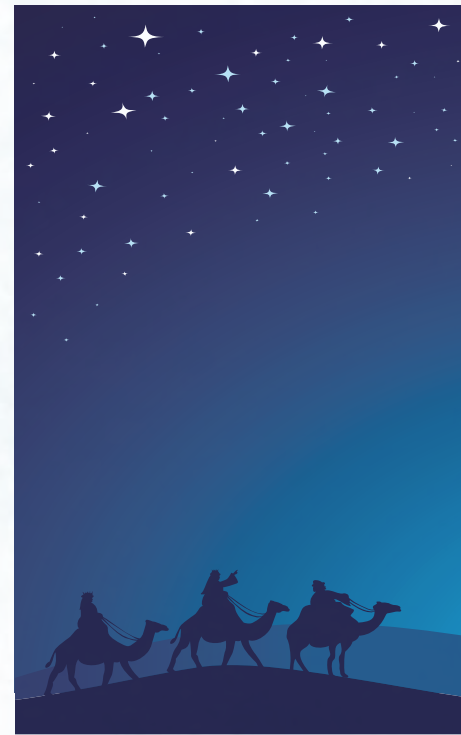
“Then the angel said to them, ‘Do not be afraid, for behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy which will be to all people. For there is born to you this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord. And this will be the sign to you: You will find a Babe wrapped in swaddling cloths, lying in a manger.’

“And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God and saying: ‘Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, goodwill toward men!’

“So it was, when the angels had gone away from them into heaven, that the shepherds said to one another, ‘Let us now go to Bethlehem and see this thing that has come to pass, which the Lord has made known to us.’

“And they came with haste and found Mary and Joseph, and the Babe lying in a manger. Now when they had seen Him, they made widely known the saying which was told them concerning this Child. And all those who heard it marveled at those things which were told them by the shepherds. But Mary kept all these things and pondered them in her heart.

“Then the shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all the things that they had heard and seen, as it was told them” (Luke 2:1-20, NKJV).

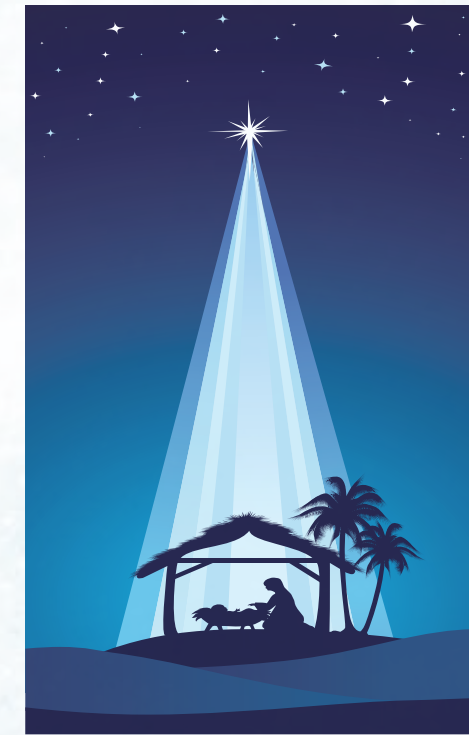


What a divinely glorious first Christmas! Joseph and Mary had traveled slowly to Bethlehem because she was near the end of her supernatural pregnancy. By the time of their arrival, the inn was full. There were no vacancies. Please do not fault the innkeeper; surely he provided for them as well as he could have. The stables would protect Mary from the cool night air. While there, the time comes for Mary to be delivered, and she gives birth to the Son of God, Emanuel, who is to be known as Jesus. With the birth of our Lord, the celebration of the first Christmas was underway.

Shepherd’s had gathered their sheep for the night and were relaxing around a campfire when suddenly an angel of the Lord stood before them, and the glory of the Lord lightened all the area around them. The Scripture states they were afraid, which sounds like a natural reaction to an unexpected event. Quickly, the angel dispelled their fear when he said, **“Do not be afraid, for behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy . . . For there is born to you this day in the city of David, a Savior who is Christ the Lord.”**

Just as the angel finished his amazing statement, a multitude of fellow angels appeared, saying, **“Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, goodwill toward men!”**

Can you imagine such an occasion and how you might respond? Once the angels had departed for heaven, the shepherd’s took action. They agreed to go into Bethlehem to see the fulfillment of prophecy that was made known to them. Notice they meet Mary and Joseph and observe the



Babe lying in a manger. Once they see Him, they go throughout the area telling everyone their experience with the angels and encounter with the Child.

Here is another very interesting Bible fact: As the angels announce Jesus’ birth, God directs the wise men from the Orient to begin following a star that will lead them to Him who is to be born King of the Jews.

The shepherd’s testimony has a profound effect on people. I am reminded of Isaiah 55:11: **“So shall My word be that goes forth from My mouth; it shall not return to Me void, but it shall accomplish what I please, and it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it.”** (NKJV)

May I remind you that there is no better time to share your testimony than during the season in which we are celebrating the birth of our Lord Jesus—Christmas?

Luke 2:19 states, **“But Mary kept all these things and pondered them in her heart.”** The reason for her deep thoughts is revealed in Luke 1:26-38.

The Righteous Remnant

Have you ever given thought to the background of Mary, Joseph, and the shepherds? They were members of the righteous remnant of Israel, as were the parents of John the Baptist, Zacharias and Elizabeth. Simeon and Anna of Luke 2:25-38 were also of the righteous remnant.

As you know, until the angel of the Lord spoke to the shepherds, there had been no voice of any kind to the people of Israel for 400 years. The declaration of the angel of the Lord and those who joined him were the first words from God, the Most High, and they announced the birth of Jesus to members of the righteous remnant of the Jewish people. Notice also that the Holy Spirit led Simeon to the temple the day Jesus was brought for circumcision. Anna was a prophetess among the righteous remnant. How wonderful to discover that the Holy Spirit helped the righteous during the centuries of Israel's backslidings (Luke 2:25-38). As a note of history, the temple was the second temple about which Jesus would later prophesy its destruction.

The wise men, following the star, were God-fearing Oriental descendants of Abraham and were aware of a coming King of the Jews. The star, which God provided, was the first GPS (global positioning system).

The Second Christmas—Jesus' First Birthday
The second Christmas was also celebrated in Bethlehem as Joseph and Mary continued in his hometown. Jesus was raised in the customs and culture of His devout Jewish parents. Joseph, a fine carpenter, supported his family through his hard work.

Jesus reached his first birthday. His family was no longer residing in the stables behind an inn—they were in more comfortable quarters. Jesus, although a toddler, was walking and communicating with His parents in baby language, just as did yours and mine. It was a blessed birthday. Mary continued to ponder in her heart all that had been spoken to her by the angel of the Lord and Simeon in the temple.

The Third Christmas—Giving of Gifts
By the time Jesus was two-years-old, Joseph was a successful carpenter in Bethlehem. Mary continued to care lovingly for her child, the Son of God. While doing her housework, there was a knock on the door. The wise men had arrived to worship and bring valuable gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh for Jesus. During their visit, the Holy Spirit warned them in a dream not to return to King Herod, as he would seek to kill the Christ child. So, they left the country by another way. However, the third celebration of Christmas established the giving of gifts for the future of the Christ child, Jesus.

Following the departure of the wise men, who were astronomers—not astrologers—God appeared to Joseph in a dream and instructed him to take the Child and Mary to Egypt quickly. Because of the gifts from the wise men, Joseph was able to secure the best and fastest means of departure. They lived incognito in Egypt until King Herod's death. Jesus celebrated His birthdays with Mary and Joseph in Egypt until

Joseph brought them to Nazareth. The ample gifts from the wise men sustained them and allowed Joseph to purchase a home and place of business in Nazareth—where they were blessed (Deut. 28:1-13).

Christmas Today
There is much to be learned from the Holy Scriptures about Christmas—the celebration of the birth of our Savior and Lord. There must be worship, prayer, and the bringing of valuable gifts to support His ministry, so others may know about Him.

The secular world has taken advantage of this time of the year. They celebrate with parties, drinking, and by giving expensive gifts to each other. Among them are those who are uninvited, left out, overlooked, and alone. Christmas without a family, or at least a church family, can be the most lonesome time of the year. After a secular Christmas, in which little or no thought is given to Jesus, many are filled with regret and are often in debt.

I personally have much to celebrate this Christmas. Because of the gift of healing, I am healed of fourth-stage colon cancer and am again about my assignment in the ministry of our Lord. I am abundantly blessed. I will celebrate this Christmas with both my family and church family. Susan and I are preparing a special gift to advance the glorious ministry of Jesus, so others may have an opportunity to accept Him.

Jesus is the Heart of Christmas
May I suggest making this Christmas one in which Jesus is the centerpiece of ALL your activities? Share Him with your family and close friends. Send cards with a clear message about Jesus, not Santa Claus. Do not load your credit cards and later struggle to make payments. Gather the family for a candle light church service and a wonderful Christmas dinner. Do not join the worldly crowd in their affairs where Satan can tempt you to participate in their sinful satisfying of the lust of the flesh. Do not join the secular crowd with messages of "Happy Holidays." Instead, respond heartily with "MERRY CHRISTMAS."

Remember, Jesus was born to establish His life-giving message and to give Himself for you and me. Be as generous as were the wise men with your gift into the ministry of Jesus.

I am praying that this Christmas will be the most spiritual and blessed of all your previous ones. Worship, pray, give, and take advantage of the season to tell others about your living Savior, the Son of God—Emanuel—born of the virgin Mary.

Prophecies of Jesus

Before the birth of our Lord Jesus and throughout His life, Bible prophecy played a special role.

The prophet Isaiah not only prophesied His virgin birth, but also the price He would pay in order to redeem you and me. Read Isaiah's prophecy carefully beginning in chapter 53, verse 1:

"Who believes what we've heard and seen? Who would have thought God's saving power would look like this? The servant grew up before God—a scrawny seedling, a scrubby plant in a parched field. There was nothing attractive about him, nothing to cause us to take a second look. He was looked down on and passed over, a man who suffered, who knew pain firsthand. One look at him and people turned away. We looked down on him, thought he was scum. But the fact is, it was our pains he carried—our disfigurements, all the things wrong with us. We thought he brought it on himself, that God was punishing him for his own failures. But it was our sins that did that to him, that ripped and tore and crushed him—our sins! He took the punishment, and that made us whole. Through his bruises we get healed. We're all like sheep who've wandered off and gotten lost. We've all done our own thing, gone our own way. And God has piled all our sins, everything we've done wrong, on him.

"He was beaten, he was tortured, but he didn't say a word. Like a lamb taken to be slaughtered and like a sheep being sheared, he took it all in silence. Justice miscarried, and he was led off—and did anyone really know what was happening? He died without a thought for his own welfare, beaten bloody for the sins of my people. They buried him with the wicked, threw him in a grave with a rich man, even though he'd never hurt a soul or said one word that wasn't true.

"Still, it's what God had in mind all along, to crush him with pain. The plan was that he give himself as an offering for sin so that he'd see life come from it—life, life, and more life. And God's plan will deeply prosper through him.

"Out of that terrible travail of soul, he'll see that it's worth it and be glad he did it. Through what he experienced, my righteous one, my servant, will make many 'righteous ones,' as he himself carries the burden of their sins. Therefore I'll reward him extravagantly—the best of everything, the highest honors—Because he looked death in the face and didn't flinch, because he embraced the company of the lowest. He took on his own shoulders the sin of the many, he took up

the cause of all the black sheep." (Isa. 53, *The Message*).

Throughout the Gospels, Jesus prophesied His death and resurrection. As often as He did so, one would think the disciples would have understood and not been so distressed when He was crucified. Even at His resurrection, the disciples were amazed, and Thomas doubted. Apparently, like many of Jesus' present followers, the disciples were not hearing His prophecy. However, once He had walked out of the tomb, it was a different story.

Why are many Christians today unaware that biblical prophecies are now being fulfilled at a faster rate than ever before in history? Within the Church, there is only a slight more emphasis on Bible prophecy than in past years. In the 1920s, 1930s, and early 1940s, there was a stronger emphasis on Jesus' coming soon than today. In those times, the nation of Israel had not yet begun to be restored. Bible prophecies pertaining to the time of the end awaited the moment of Israeli restoration. Once Israel was born in a day (Isa. 66:8), which occurred on May 15, 1948, the floodgate was opened for vitally important prophecies to begin being brought to pass.

Jesus' Prophesied Events of Today

Today, we live in the most prophesied era of time. Every believer should **watch for His appearing with expectation. Soul winning** should be foremost in our thoughts and activities. Why? Because Jesus has stated that once the fig tree, Israel, is restored and becomes productive, His appearing and the final phase of redemption would be at hand.

"Now when these things begin to happen, look up and lift up your heads, because your redemption draws near. Then He spoke to them a parable: 'Look at the fig tree, and all the trees. When they are already budding, you see and know for yourselves that summer is now near. So you also, when you see these things happening, know that the kingdom of God is near'" (Luke 21:28-31, NKJV).

Let me remind you, we do not know the day nor the hour of His appearing—the Rapture (Mark 13:32-33). However, when we carefully examine the prophecies of Jesus in Matthew chapter 24, Mark chapter 13, and Luke chapter 21, we realize we are now in the season of His appearing. He is coming soon!

Since Jesus prophecies concerning Himself came to pass with

absolute accuracy, we should pay all the more attention to His prophecies that affect us today. The chapters in the above paragraph read like today's newspapers. Jesus warns, *"Take heed that no one deceives you. For many will come in My name, saying, 'I am the Christ,' and will deceive many"* (Matt. 24:4-5, NKJV). Then, He mentions wars and rumors of wars.

Presently, we are concluding our battle with international terrorists in Iraq, while fighting in Afghanistan. At the same time, all of North Africa and the Arab world are in a state of upheaval. The threats and reality of war is stronger today than ever before. Notice Jesus states, *"See that you are not troubled, for all these things must come to pass, but the end is not yet"* (Matt. 24:6). His statement, *"the end is not yet,"* is in reference to the Battle of Armageddon.

Jesus then prophesied there would be "nation against nation." The original Greek states, "ethnos against ethnos." Are there ethnic problems in our world today? Yes, as never before! Ethnic problems have the Arab world in turmoil. The news calls it "Arab Spring." The truth is ethnic problems are producing death and destruction. The same is true in North Africa and other parts of Africa. In fact, the upheavals throughout Europe and our nation are ethnic problems. The protests in our nation are referred to as "class warfare" and our President is as guilty as anyone. When unions back the so-called "Wall Street protestors," it is a form of serious ethnic problems designed to change our government to one of Marxism.

It is time the Church community pays attention to Bible prophecy, and especially the prophecies of Jesus.

Let us further examine Jesus' prophecy of "kingdom against kingdom." This is exactly what is taking place within the European Union, the Middle East, Asia, the Orient, and North and South America. The prophecy is not identified with war, but with serious disagreement to the point of being disagreeable. Sounds like Democrats and Republicans who serve themselves at our expense.

Jesus then lists famines, pestilences, and earthquakes in various places. In spite of immense worldwide food production, famine touches millions of people somewhere every day. The Greek word for "pestilence" is interpreted "malignancy," which means "that which resists treatment." Today, cancer has become a worldwide

pestilence and especially here in our nation. The medical profession states that, at present, one out of every three Americans either have cancer or will become cancerous. **It is a plague!**

Do we need to preach divine healing and pray for the sick and afflicted in our church services? Yes, and the sooner the better. A God-called minister should never excuse himself by saying "It is not my ministry." If one is truly called into the ministry of Jesus, healing is definitely a part of our calling (Matt. 4:23).

Finally, Jesus speaks of earthquakes in various places. Today, we are experiencing more destructive earthquakes than ever. In recent years, we have begun to have great earthquakes that are moving the earth's axis. Because of the powerful shifting of the earth's plates, weather patterns are changing, thus producing major upheavals of nature.

The time has come to know the prophecies of Jesus and realize the stage is being set for His appearing for the resurrection and Rapture.


I have touched briefly on the prophecies of our Lord Jesus. These important prophetic statements of Jesus all come from the three Gospel accounts of Jesus' statements to His disciples on the Mount of Olives. 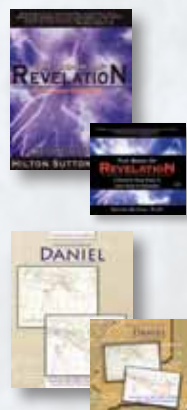

The Gift of Jesus



Greetings in the name of Jesus—the One born to take away our sins:

Wow! What a gift given to us by the Father—Jesus, the Savior. This is the time of the year we celebrate that gift and give glory and honor to His name.

This is something we should always do, and even more so as we approach the day of Jesus' appearing. The apostle Peter speaks of a time known as the Day of the Lord (II Peter 3:10).

The Day begins with the Lord coming "*as a thief in the night*" to retrieve His precious jewel—the Church, and is commonly known as the Rapture. The Day of the Lord concludes with the earth, as we know it melting away with a fervent heat. This event occurs on the final day of the 1,000-year millennial reign of Christ. This means the Day of the Lord lasts for 1,007 years, which is the duration of the Tribulation and the Millennium. (For further understanding, listen to Dr. Sutton's teaching entitled *The Day of the Lord*—see page 8).

Moreover, what I want you to notice is the next verse of Second Peter that states, "*What manner of persons ought you to be in holy conduct and godliness*" (II Pet. 3:11). This word "conduct" refers to one's behavior. As Christians, our everyday behavior should be holy and God-like. The word "holy" simply means to be set apart unto God. Peter also tells us to be holy as the Father is holy (I Pet. 1:16). You see, the Father is set apart for you. Everything He has done, He has done for you. He waits to hear your voice daily to answer your prayers. He also waits for you to open His book, so He can speak to you and give you revelation about His love for you.

God is a Giver

Giving is a behavior of God. He is love, and love never takes selfishly, it always gives. The reason we give gifts at Christmas is because the Father first gave us Jesus, giving gifts to celebrate the birth of Jesus was then established by the wise men (see Dr. Sutton's article entitled *The First Three Christmases*). By giving His Son to mankind, God set an example of behavior, which is giving in abundance. To be holy as God is holy, we should be set apart for God to use us—including using us to give.

The act of giving can be meeting someone's specific need, or it can be simply honoring a servant of God.

The many benefits of giving are documented throughout the Word of God. Luke 6:38 states, "*Give, and it shall be given unto you; good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and running over, shall men give into your bosom. For with the same measure that ye mete withal it shall be measured to you again.*" Paul states, "*He who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and*

he who sows bountifully will also reap bountifully."

In relation to giving the tithe, God says, "*Bring all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be food in My house, and try Me now in this . . . If I will not open for you the windows of heaven and pour out for you such blessing that there will not be room enough to receive it*" (Mal. 3:10).

Honoring the Ministry of Jesus on the Earth
